The Riverview Fund is active in supporting local communities where Riverview has farms. Here are a few of the recent contributions:

**MN - Wendell Pickleball & Playground:** The City of Wendell is working on upgrading the playground equipment and basketball and pickleball court for their area youth and community. The goal is to create an attraction to their community to encourage growth. They began dirt work on the project, and we are excited to watch their vision come to life.

**MN - Pillsbury Park Project:** Pillsbury Park has been a central part of Kerkhoven for generations, and the town is excited to move forward with a new and improved playground for the community. The Kerkhoven Parks & Rec Committee is excited to have 20% of their funding secured and they are working on reaching their goal by the end of 2026 to have the park completed by summer of 2027.

**MN - Campbell-Tintah School Library:** The Campbell-Tintah school has not been able to maximize the use of their school library due to the state of the space. In November, they began renovating the space for a new and improved library that the entire school will be able to utilize. Riverview's Red River team has already been there to help complete phase one of the projects which was clearing out the current space.
